ALL STUDENTS WILL DRESS UP IN HONOR OF THE BLESSED MOTHER

All First Communicants will wear their First Communion outfits. Following the Procession and the Liturgy the students may change into their uniform or other dress clothes. **(No jeans or shorts)**

Grades K-6 will dress up or wear their uniform.

(No jeans or shorts) Dresses and skirts must follow the Dress Code

Grades 7 & 8 will dress up. Boys will wear dress slacks or khakis with shirts and ties. Girls will dress up. **The girls will not be permitted to wear sleeveless dresses unless they wear a sweater. The length of the girls' dresses or skirts must follow the Dress Code.**

(No jeans or shorts for the girls or boys)

Sandals may be worn **(no flip flops)**

ALL STUDENTS WILL REMAIN DRESSED UP FOR THE ENTIRE DAY —EXCEPT FOR THE SECOND GRADE WHO WILL CHANGE OUT OF THEIR FIRST COMMUNION OUTFITS.
